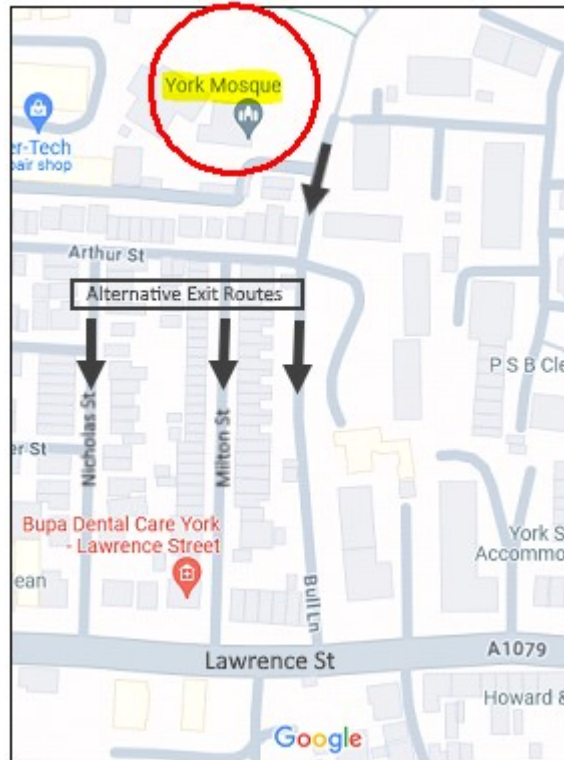

1. Introduction

Welcome to York Mosque. Please be aware that the mosque is run by a *small* community of Muslims from different nationalities, and is frequented by student families from the local universities and visitors from surrounding cities for daily prayers (or weekly activities).

In order to ensure your stay is as pleasant as possible, please follow the guidance in this leaflet as best as you can. *JazakAllahu Khaira!*

2. Mosque Opening Hours

We would like to keep the mosque open throughout the day, but due to staff shortage, it is open only during the 5-daily prayer times (about 15 mins ahead and 30 mins afterwards). If you happen to visit us outside these times, please use the open space (gazebo) near the entrance to the mosque. We apologise for any inconvenience caused by the time restrictions.

3. Parking Restrictions/Speed Limit

The car parking area is built on soft grounds (over a landfill site) and has weight limits. Therefore, please **do not** bring any vans or heavy goods vehicles (HGV) on to the site (but feel free to use the main road or the *Park & Ride* car park on Hull Road/A1079).

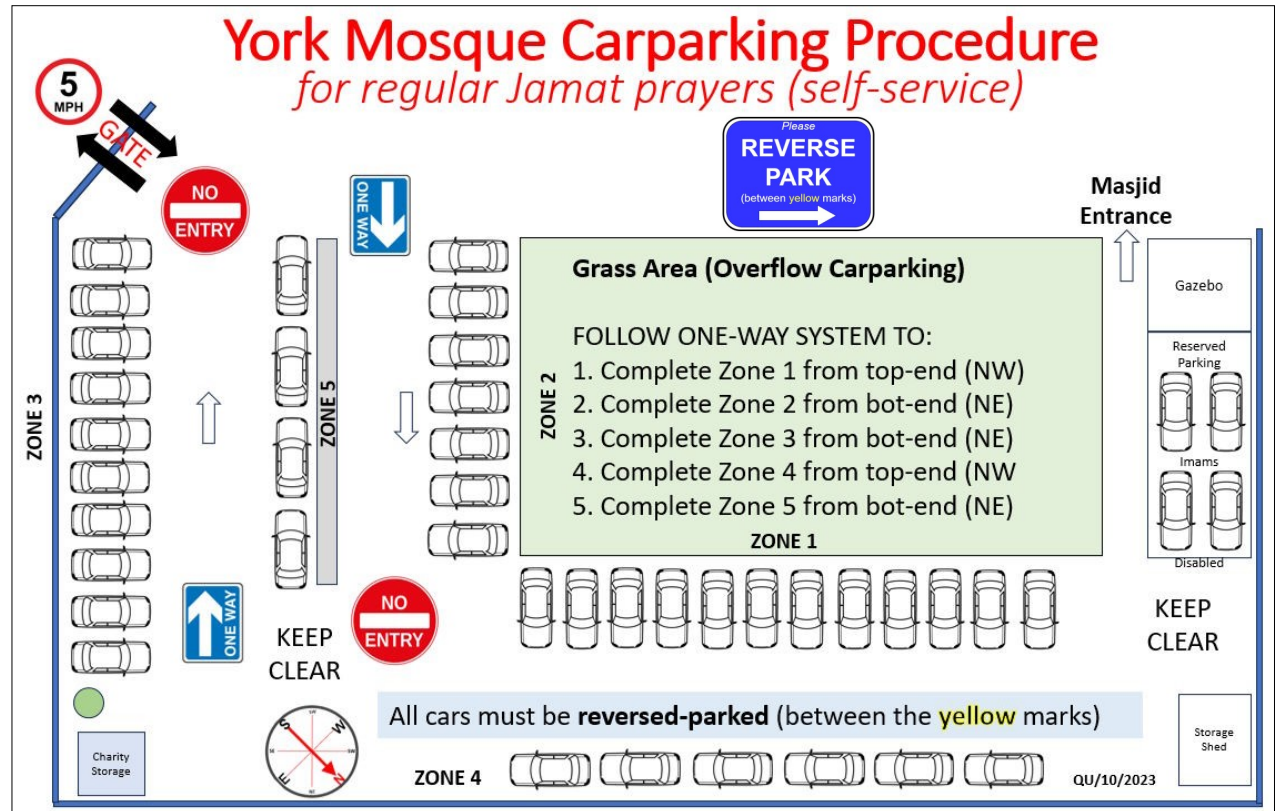


When entering the mosque gate, please ensure your car speed is dead-slow (5-mph) and keep to the left, following the **one-way** system at all times (even if the car park is empty). This speed limit applies at all times on site (i.e. when entering *and* leaving the car park).



4. Parking Zones/Yellow Marks

To avoid inconvenience to those who come late or to those who wish to leave early (after Jamat), we have divided the car park into a number of Zones (1-5). Please complete the Zone in the **order** stated in the map below and ensure you



always **reverse-park** between the **yellow marks** on the curve (to maximise the usage of space and easily exit the car park without reversing).

The Zone 1 is near the mosque entrance, which should be filled first from the top-end, followed by Zone 2 opposite the old mosque and then Zone 3 near the gate (avoiding the KEEP CLEAR areas).

5. One Way/No Entry

When leaving the car park, please ensure you follow the left lane (One Way) and do not enter the right lane (No Entry) under any circumstance, to avoid potential accidents or damage to other cars or mosque property (e.g. sign posts).

6. Double Parking/Exit Time

During peak times (e.g. Jummah) it may be necessary to double-park the cars as directed by the *Parking Attendants*. If your car is parked on the entry/exit lanes, please ensure you remove it immediately after the obligatory prayers (to an empty space on Zone 1-3, if necessary). Please avoid parking on the grass area or the gate ways.
